Check the GSQA website for upcoming schedule for meeting, show cancellation and seminars.

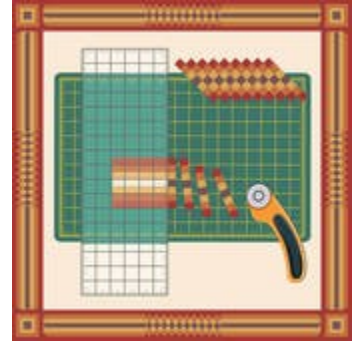
