*Inspiration – Ashley Fleming – Read a story with theme "accept what life gives you and use it without trying to fix it."

*Pam Pulley from the Linas Project spoke. The organization was founded in 1995 in Colorado and is in all 50 states. They provide blankets to children in crisis. The bulk of blankets she receives goes to USA Children & Women Hospital. Pam doesn't stipulate what size blanket she receives as the recipients can range from age birth to age 18. She also gives them to police and firemen. JoAnn Fabrics is a drop off location. She also receives crocheted blankets.

*Diane Engels presented 33 quilts to Pam from our Guild.

GSQA – Their Quilt Show will be this weekend at the Harbor Center in Slidell. The meeting will be April 20th in New Orleans with Rob Appel as quest speaker.

She took home 6 quilts from last months Show & Tell so she gave them 3 more and gave 33 today to Linus Project. Pam gave her a couple of Project Linas brochures if anyone is interested. Diane has some kits if you want to make a child quilt. She said she can't accept any more scraps of fabric unless they are large squares or pieces that can be backing. She also won't' be able to take any more batting in pieces—only batting that's large enough to be the backing.
